

## About 2010 Census

### What

#### Count

The census is a count of everyone residing in the United States.

### Who

All residents of the United States must be counted. This includes people of all ages, races, ethnic groups - citizens and non-citizens.

### Where

The census counts everyone residing in the United States: in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the Island Areas. People should be counted at the address where they live and sleep most of the year.

### How

The Census Bureau will mail or deliver questionnaires to your residence in March 2010. We will mail a second form to households that do not respond to the initial questionnaire.

Households that still do not respond will be called or visited by a Census worker. (Census workers can be identified by a census badge and bag.)

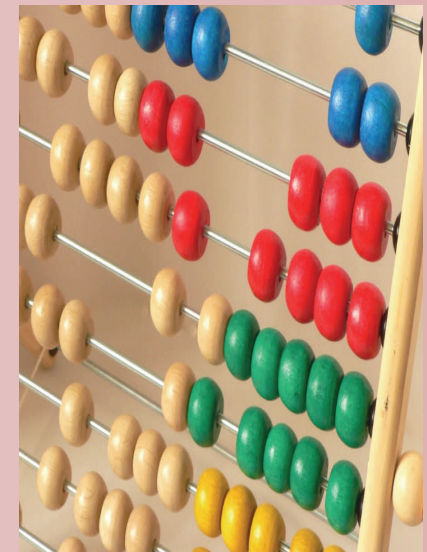

### 1. What is the census?

### 2. Is my information confidential?

Federal law protects the personal info. Shared during the census.

### 3. Do I have to complete the census form?

Your participation in the census is required by law.
